Keystone Mission and The Weinberg Food Bank (CEO) have partnered together to offer the Emergency Food Assistance. The program will provide emergency bags of food for families, individuals, or seniors in the community who are in need and have been directly impacted by the COVID-19 crisis.

Q: Who is Eligible for the Emergency Food Assistance?

A: Families, individuals, or seniors who have been directly impacted by the COVID-19 outbreak. Examples may be loss of a job, unable to work and provide for family, or those who are unable to support themselves or their families.

Q: When are the Food Bags Available?

A: The emergency food bags are available Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m. You can call or come to either the Scranton or Wilkes-Barre facility to receive your food.
